

School Safety Information Sharing

The Statewide Terrorism & Intelligence Center's (STIC) School Safety Information Sharing Program is designed to identify the information needs of school and campus safety officials and ensure timely and wide dissemination of actionable intelligence. The program goal is to aid school safety efforts through information sharing from local, state and federal agencies with every school and campus in the State of Illinois.

Target Members:

- Administrators or those in charge of making safety decisions in schools and campuses
- · Sworn police officers involved in school and campus safety

Members have access to:

- A dedicated K-12 and campus intelligence officer
- For Official Use Only (FOUO) information designed for those who "need to know" to aid school and campus safety
- Law Enforcement Sensitive (LES) information related to school and campus safety (Sworn Law Enforcement Officers Only)
- Newsletters outlining state and national trends, free school or campus safety training, and other material to help make better safety decisions and improve safety and related decisions
- · Monthly webinars

STIC is the State of Illinois' designated fusion center, which is a collaboration of state and federal agencies designated to look at all crimes and hazards in order to protect the public. STIC has been fully functional since May 2003 as one of the first 365/24/7 state fusion centers.
